RE: Senator Doug Jones

Dear Ethics Committee Members,

The Foundation for Accountability and Civic Trust (FACT) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to promoting accountability, ethics, and transparency in government and civic arenas. We achieve this mission by hanging a lantern over public officials who put their own interest over the interests of the public good.

We request the Senate Select Committee on Ethics immediately investigate Senator Doug Jones for using official resources for campaign and political purposes. Senator Jones consistently uses his campaign Twitter account to link to his official Twitter account. For instance, on January 23, 2020, Jones' campaign account states, "Retweeting in a trial break here . . ." and links to Jones' official Senate tweet that displays a video that appears to be Jones in his Senate office. There are numerous examples dating back to January 2019, all using official resources for political purposes, 28 of which are attached.

Federal law and Senate Ethics Rules prohibit Senators from using official resources for campaign or political activity.³ Official resources include government buildings, staff, and websites and social media accounts. The Senate Rules explicitly prohibit "[1]inking or posting from a campaign

² The @DougJones Twitter account is clearly functioning as a campaign account. The bio section links to his campaign website dougjones.com. From this public account, he posts campaign ads (i.e., https://twitter.com/DougJones/status/927560986772541440), campaign materials, and fundraising solicitations (i.e., https://twitter.com/DougJones/status/1170870945470455808). This account has roughly 225,000 more followers than the @DougJonesHQ (Doug Jones for Senate) account. Moreover, the content of the posts over the past few months are political. *Compare* U.S. Office of Special Counsel, OSC File No. HA-17-4341, Letter Dated Sep. 28, 2017 (finding a Twitter account was not a "personal" account based upon content of posts were about official matters, even though "there were personal posts and photographs as well").

website controlled by or under the direction of a Member or group of Members to an Official Website." A "website" is defined to include social media, *e.g.* Twitter.⁵

Jones has committed multiple clear violations by using his official publicly funded social media account for political purposes. It is the Ethics Committee's purpose to ensure Senators follow straightforward laws, but this type of violation is especially concerning because it enforces the belief that incumbent Senators abuse taxpayer funded resources simply for their reelection efforts and for political purposes. Therefore, we request the Committee immediately investigate and act on Senator Jones' apparent violations.


