Court STAYED sentence and placed defendant on PROBATION for 5 years, concurrent with sentence on 18CM3953. CONDITIONS OF PROBATION/EXTENDED SUPERVISION: AODA assessment, comply with recommended treatment. Absolute sobriety; random urine screens. No possession or use of phones with recording capabilities. No social media. Sex offender evaluation; comply with recommended treatment. Compose a letter of apology to the victim, to be given to agent. Treatment and/or counseling as determined by agent. Serve 1 year condition time at the House of Corrections, straight time. Provide a DNA sample. Pay court costs, fees, and surcharges including: DNA surcharge to be paid during period of probation, if revoked to be paid by defendant's prison funds at a percentage to be determined by the DOC, remainder to be paid during the period of extended supervision; failure to pay will result in a civil judgment. Court ordered cash bail held on deposit, pending restitution hearing on case 18CM3953. Appeal rights given. Filed: Pretrial Sentence Credit, Notice of Right to Seek Post-Conviction Relief.
