Gwinnett County Public Schools, its employees, agents, and representatives are permitted to use the Content within Gwinnett County Public Schools for the any non-commercial use, but shall be prohibited from sharing, distributing, or disseminating the Content to institutions or individuals outside of Gwinnett County Public Schools. PHOTO/VIDEO RELEASE

INTRODUCTION

EL Education is fiercely focused on equity for all children. All children deserve schools that foster their unique abilities, give them real opportunity to achieve high academic standards, and help them take their full place in a society for which they are well prepared when they leave school. EL Education believes data to be an essential lever for improving and promoting quality implementation of our Language Arts Curriculum to ensure improved outcomes for all students. To this end, EL Education partners with Districts in reviewing data on a continual basis, using the results to inform strategic planning and professional learning for district staff.

This Data Sharing Agreement ("Data Agreement") dated 6/10/2022 is entered by and between ("District") and EL Education for the purpose of establishing the roles and responsibilities of each party with respect to sharing data to assess implementation and outcomes related to the EL Education Language Arts Curriculum.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, EL Education seeks to improve student achievement and teacher practice through the combination of EL Education's Language Arts Curriculum, powerful professional learning, strategic planning, and deep expert coaching support.

WHEREAS, the District has adopted EL Education's Language Arts Curriculum and The District and EL Education desire to track implementation progress toward mutual goals including documenting teacher and student impact.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, terms and conditions set forth herein, the parties do hereby agree as follows:

1. Scope of the Data Sharing Agreement.

The Parties agree that EL Education has the authority to collect, analyze, and use evidence to investigate and improve the impact of EL Education's Language Arts Curriculum and Professional Services on student achievement, quality of instruction, and teacher practice in the manner set forth in the Curriculum Services agreement with Gwinnett County Public Schools for the 2022-2023 school year, dated 6/10/2022, and which this agreement is intended to serve as a supplemental appendix. This includes data collected and reported in the EL Education Dimensions Data Platform (see Terms and Conditions of Use). The district agrees to share data listed in Section 2 below.

Based on the ability of the materials to satisfy GCPS requirements, the completeness of the vendor response, and the vendor's capabilities to meet the overall implementation and delivery requirements, GCPS may choose to further evaluate and incorporate those selected materials for further approval/adoption/ purchase per the terms and conditions of the appropriate Instructional Resource Adoption Agreement process. Any resources that are adopted for district-wide implementation will be purchased at the same price per unit as was in effect at the time of pilot purchase. The resource price and unit of measure entered on the GCPS Instructional Resources Vendor Database before initiation of the pilot (and as stated in Attachment A of this agreement) shall remain in effect for the term of the adoption contract.

GCPS is under no obligation to extend this contract, adopt pilot materials, or further purchase any materials from Publisher.

GCPS may reject any conditional or incomplete pilot or included materials which contain irregularities of any kind. Additionally, GCPS reserves the right to reject any or all responses to this pilot. GCPS reserves the right to withdraw this pilot Agreement by written notice. GCPS shall incur no liability whatsoever to prospective vendors by reason of such withdrawal, rejection or acceptance, or further obligations once a cancellation or withdrawal notice has been sent. GCPS further reserves the right to accept materials from one or more prospective vendors.

Copyright Date: To be eligible for approval/adoption consideration, all of the Publisher's resources must be current and have a copyright date of 2017 or later unless the subject matter has not become outdated. If GCPS determines that the content is current and accurate, it may recommend at its sole discretion an instructional resource that has a copyright date earlier than 2017. The Publisher represents and warrants that it owns or has rights to the copyright of all instructional resources listed.
- D. Correlations: Publisher may be required to electronically submit a correlation between each resource submitted and the Academic Knowledge and Skills (AKS) and Indicators of Achievement of GCPS and/or the Georgia Standards of Excellence/Georgia Performance Standards, preferably in IMS Global CASE format.
- E. Gifts or Gratuities: The following excerpts from GCPS Board of Education policy apply:
 - GCPS employees shall not accept a gift favor, loan, reward, political contribution, gratuity, entertainment, transportation, lodging, or meals from students, parents, or potential suppliers who conduct business with GCPS except those of nominal value (less than \$50.00), which must be disclosed to the immediate supervisor and the Department of Internal Audits. Advertising items and instructional products that are widely distributed may be accepted.
 - 2. GCPS employees are expressly prohibited from soliciting from any present or potential supplier (person, company, firm, or corporation) the right/privilege to purchase goods or services for personal use at prices offered the school system through bids and/or quotes.
 - 3. In the event a company provides unsolicited incentive type gifts with the shipment of an order, the items should be turned over to the Purchasing Department for disposition. Disposition will be

as follows:

- a. Items which have no bearing on school business will be disposed of in the best interest of the school system.
- b. Items which can be instructionally utilized will be forwarded to requesting school.

Publisher and Publisher's representatives shall not contact GCPS employees for the purpose of promoting text/ instructional resources submitted for recommendation. These provisions will be strictly enforced.

- **F. Digital Resources:** Refer to Attachment C for the digital requirements and technical specifications for any digital instructional resources.
- **G.** Shipping: Prices quoted are freight-on-board (FOB) destination. Freight should be prepaid and charged back to the invoice as a separate line item. Freight charges may not exceed the actual freight charges to vendor and shall never exceed 5% of total cost of physical items/ print materials. GCPS is not responsible for materials lost in shipping. There will be no "handling" charges.
- H. Payment Terms: Publisher will not delete items from a Purchase Order (PO) without prior notification and approval from GCPS. Publisher is to provide a separate invoice for each delivery (not combining multiple packing slips/shipments on the same invoice). Payment will be made upon receipt of goods/ successful implementation of digital components.
- I. Delivery of Materials: Publisher agrees to maintain a sufficient inventory of items referenced in this contract to provide timely delivery of ordered materials. Timely delivery shall mean the receipt of materials at the GCPS Distribution Center within 15 business days from the date the purchase order is provided to the Publisher. The Publisher must communicate "delayed shipment" status to the GCPS Instructional Resources Office in writing for all materials that will not meet the timely delivery requirement and specify the new delivery date(s) for each delayed item. In these cases, GCPS reserves the right to modify the terms of the purchase order, cancel the order, or assess penalties.
- J. Kits: If kits are included as a part of this contract, Publisher is to supply a detailed listing of individual items within the kit, including a description of each item. A price listing which is valid for the life of the contract will be generated by GCPS and included as Attachment A1. The entire kit and its components will be at a fixed price for the term of the contract. Publisher agrees to remove any unwanted components out of kits adopted by GCPS prior to delivery.
- K. Distribution of Material: Vendor authorizes GCPS to distribute materials, including graphics, from teacher resource materials for use in the GCPS professional development and instructional/assessment databases. This material may be distributed and used by GCPS employees only on the GCPS wide area network for instructional and training purposes only. Classroom use of materials will comply with copyright. Rights for use in these databases may extend beyond the term of the contract.
- L. Submission of Revisions: Publisher must request pre-approval in writing to the Director of Instructional Resources and Support to substitute a revised resource for a resource currently under pilot. This condition applies to any change to the original edition including typographical corrections in the copy. The request must contain details of the revised information and an itemized list of the changes in the revised edition. In addition, a minimum of two complete sets of preview copies of the

revised resource (including student edition, teacher edition, and all ancillary items) will be provided. This requirement applies to electronic/digital versions of the text and components as well.

The revised edition must be classroom compatible with the original edition. Classroom compatible means that the revised edition can be used in the same classroom with the earlier edition without detriment to either the student using the revised edition or the teacher having students using both editions. GCPS in its sole discretion shall determine if a resource is classroom compatible. Resources that do not meet the requirements for classroom compatibility will not be considered suitable for substitution. If the revised edition is not classroom compatible, GCPS in its sole discretion may accept the edition as a substitute, subject to any conditions set forth by GCPS to minimize lack of compatibility.

- M. Laws and Regulations: The Publisher agrees to adhere to all requirements of Georgia Law and State Board rules pertaining to instructional resources. If any provision of this Agreement shall be held invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate or render unenforceable any other provision hereof. This Agreement is for the benefit of the parties hereto only and is not intended to benefit any third parties or to give rise to any duty or causes of action for any third party.
- N. Amendments: No modifications or alteration of this Contract will be valid or effective unless each modification or alteration is made as an amendment to this Agreement and signed by both parties.
- O. Termination for Cause: The occurrence of any one or more of the following events shall constitute cause for GCPS to declare the Publisher in default of its obligations under the Contract:
 - The Publisher fails to deliver or has delivered nonconforming service(s)/product(s) of the Agreement; a component fails to perform to the satisfaction of GCPS; or a component is in violation of a material provision of the Agreement;
 - 2. GCPS determines that satisfactory performance of the Agreement is substantially endangered or that a default is likely to occur;
 - 3. The Publisher fails to make substantial and timely progress toward performance of the Agreement
 - 4. The Publisher becomes subject to any bankruptcy or insolvency proceeding under federal or state law to the extent allowed by applicable federal or state law including bankruptcy laws; the Publisher terminates or suspends its business; or GCPS reasonably believes that the Publisher has become insolvent or unable to pay its obligations as they accrue consistent with applicable federal or state law;
 - 5. The Publisher has failed to comply with applicable federal, state and local laws, rules, ordinances, regulations and orders when performing within the scope of the Agreement;
 - 6. The Publisher has engaged in conduct that has or may expose GCPS to liability, as determined in the sole discretion of GCPS; or
 - 7. The Publisher has infringed any patent, trademark, copyright, trade dress, or any other intellectual property rights of GCPS or a third party.

Notice of Default: If there is a default event caused by the Publisher, GCPS shall provide written notice to the Publisher requesting that the breach or noncompliance be remedied within the period specified in the written notice to the Publisher. If the breach or noncompliance is not remedied within the period of time specified in the written notice, GCPS, as appropriate, may:







Please note the following requirements:


- All purchase orders (POs) must be shipped with separate packing slips. <u>Do not</u> put
 multiple purchase orders on the same packing slip or mix materials for one packing
 slip/purchase order with items for another order in the same box or shipment.
- 2. All items ordered must be shipped in the original manufacturer's carton and in full case quantities as ordered. NO MIXED CARTONS. All titles are to be packaged separately.
 - Exceptions can be made if:
 - 1. An item is subject to going to a backorder status with a vendor, prohibiting the shipment from meeting the required due date on purchase order.
 - 2. GCPS does not order in full case quantities.
 - Non-original manufacturer's carton shipments will be accepted; however, the cartons
 must be labeled on the outside of each carton with the manufacturer's item ID and
 quantity contained in each carton.
- 3. All packing slips must be easily found in a packing slip pouch and all purchase order numbers must be clearly labeled on all invoices, cartons, Bills of Lading, and packing slips.
 - <u>Single and multi-carton/package shipments</u>: The packing slip must be located on the <u>outside</u> and on <u>top</u> of the <u>#1</u> carton/package to which it belongs along with all cartons being labeled with the carton count on each carton (e.g., 1 of 3, 2 of 3, 3 of 3).
 - <u>Single-skid shipments</u>: The packing slip must be located on the <u>outside</u> and on <u>top</u> of the skid to which it belongs.
 - <u>Multi-skid shipments</u>: The packing slip must be located on the <u>outside</u> and on <u>top</u> of the #1 skid of the multi-skid shipment to which it belongs.

- *An exception can be made if a full skid with the same purchase order number is shrink wrapped and clearly labeled with the purchase order number and number of cartons, so it is easy to match multiple skids for the same order together.
- 4. All cartons/packages must have the manufacturer's item ID and quantity clearly labeled on the outside of each carton. All labels on full skid shipments must be facing outwards, so all cartons/packages can be easily read and received.



- 5. All partial boxes/packages must be clearly labeled (e.g., Partial Box, etc.) and be on top of the skid.
- 6. All full skid shipments <u>must be</u> shipped as follows: All cartons/packages palletized by manufacturer's items ID.
 - Note Skids can be stacked on one another to reduce shipping cost; however, a skid

 - When multiple quantities of the same kit are shipped on a pallet and each kit contains
 multiple cartons, please segregate as follows: all box #1's of kit to be on one pallet, all
 box #2's of kit to be on 2nd pallet, etc.

A. GCPS Digital Content Standards:

Gwinnett County Public Schools (GCPS) is committed to the transformation of its educational delivery system from printed textbooks in the classroom to electronic delivery of digital content to all stakeholders - teachers, administrators, students, parents, and the community. Connectivity to platforms via the Gwinnett County Public Schools portal is expected of all digital content, and the use of single sign on methods is strongly preferred.

As a foundational component of our strategy for integrated content delivery going forward, GCPS asks that content providers commit to moving toward and achieving certification of their platforms with these IMS Global standards for interoperability as applicable:

- Learning Tools Interoperability Standard: Version 1.0, 1.1 (Version 1.3 projected by summer 2022)
- Common Cartridge Interoperability Standard: Version 1.3
- OneRoster: Version 1.0, 1.1 (Version 1.1 strongly preferred)
- OneRoster API Rest: Version 1.1
- CASE: Version 1.0
- Caliper: Version 1.0, 1.1

For those providers that do not use these interoperability standards at the time of integration, evaluation of other connection methods will be discussed.

During the agreement period, the content providers will commit contractually to:

- Continue advancing the use of IMS Global standard certifications, keeping content platforms current with the generally accepted market standards.
- Collaborate with GCPS to share both organizations' strategic technology updates at least once a year.

A provider's demonstrated ability to support IMS Global Standards will be a direct factor in evaluation for adoptions.

B. Common Cartridges/ Thin Common Cartridges:

In the event that the site will operate, but one or more key functions is not working properly, the content provider should communicate to GCPS promptly and then provide daily updates via email or conference call until a resolution has been met.

In the event that the site is unavailable or unusable, the content provider should communicate to GCPS promptly and then provide updates at least every two hours. If resolution is not achieved in a timely fashion, GCPS may require updates every two hours via conference call including a member of the content provider's executive management team until a resolution has been met.


