School leaders will also be equipped to work with leadership teams to use *The Uncertainty Mindset Framework for Practice* to address a specific issue, problem, or uncertainty. Leaders will work in groups to address an uncertainty using the four elements of the Framework for Practice tool: (1) Dialogue with Stakeholders, (2) Consider Climate, (3) Apply an Equity Lens, & (4) Reflect & Evaluate
