### Offender Charged with Multiple Felony Counts, Including Aggravated Battery, Driving Under the Influence and Weapons Violations

**Offender:** Anthony Evans, 25  
2300 block of N. Rutherford Ave., Chicago, Illinois

**Charges:** Two (2) felony counts – Aggravated Battery/Discharge Firearm  
Three (3) felony counts – Aggravated DUI/Accident/Bodily Harm  
One (1) felony count – UUW Weapon - Machine Gun/Automatic Weapon  
One (1) felony count – UUW Weapon - Felon/Parole-Possess/Use Firearm Prior  
One (1) felony count – Aggravated Fleeing/Damage > \$300 Property  
One (1) misdemeanor count – Driving Under Influence of Alcohol  
One (1) misdemeanor count – Driving Under Influence of Alcohol BAC 0.08

**Court:** Detention Hearing – 2600 S. California – October 10, 2023

**Narrative:** The above offender was arrested on October 7, 2023, at 3:42 p.m., in the 5400 block of S. State St. He was identified as the offender who, minutes earlier, shot and injured two victims, a 28-year-old female and a 24-year-old male, in the 7100 block of S. Cottage Grove (3<sup>rd</sup> District). The offender then fled the scene and struck a Chicago Police vehicle in the 5400 block of S. State (2<sup>nd</sup> District), causing injuries. The offender was placed into custody and subsequently charged accordingly. No additional information is available at this time.
