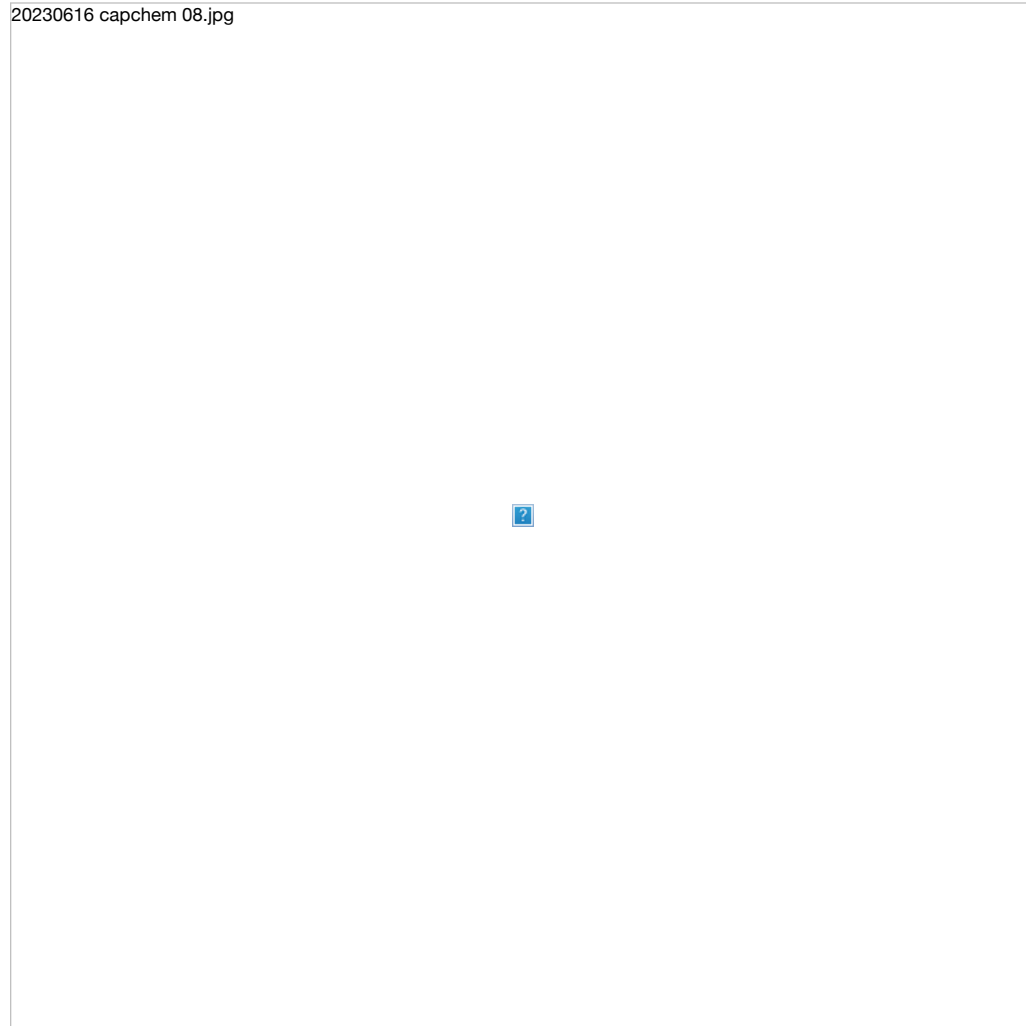

HANGING ROCK, Ohio — The Lawrence County Board of Commissioners approved a 50% tax abatement Tuesday for a Chinese company planning to build materials used in batteries for electric cars.
